

How to use

- 1. Place the cooker on a stable flat surface. Take out the cable. Measuring Cup (5) and open the Lid (2).
- 2. Fill the Measuring Cup (5) with cool water to the desired level using the Water Level Scale Guide ⑦ choosing: Hard, Medium or Soft and the number of eggs to be cooked. Pour the contents onto the Heating Plate (8).
- 3. Pierce the large end of each eag with the Eag Needle (6) (this will prevent the egg shell from cracking while the eggs are cooking). Place the eggs, pierced end up, in the Cooking Rack (1) and securely fit the Lid 2. (CAUTION: The Egg Needle 6 is very sharp – use extreme care to avoid injury or breaking the egg).
- 4. Plug ④ the cooker into the power socket and Switch ③ on. When all of the water has evaporated, an alarm will sound, signalling that the eggs are ready. Switch ③ the cooker off and unplug it from the power socket.



How to use (Continued)

- 5. With the eags still on the Cooking Rack (1), carefully remove and rinse under cold water. (CAUTION: After cooking has finished, the cooker and eggs will be very hot. Use caution when handling).
- 6. Serve eggs immediately.
- 7. It is important to keep the Heating Plate (8) clean. When cooled after use, wipe with a clean cloth.

Steamina

- 1. Fill the Measuring Cup (5) and pour the contents onto the Heating Plate (8).
- 2. Place the Steaming Platform (9) onto the Cooking Rack (1).
- 3. Place the item(s) to be steamed on top of the Steaming Platform (9).
- 4. Plug ④ the cooker into the power socket and Switch ③ on.
- 5. Cooking will continue until all of the water has evaporated, at which point an alarm will sound. The time vill vary depending on the contents of the cooker. You should use your judgement as to how long the item being steamed needs to cook.
- 6. To interrupt the cooking process before the alarm sounds Switch ③ the cooker off and carefully remove the Lid (2), taking care to protect your hands from steam.
- 7. It is important to keep the Heating Plate (8) clean. When cooled after use, wipe with a clean cloth.

Cooking Tips

- The Water Level Scale Guide (7) is based on cooking UK MEDIUM sized eggs. Timings may vary when cooking smaller or larger eags.
- For best results use eggs at room temperature
- When cooking fewer eggs, steam escapes from the steam vent at a faster rate. Therefore, in order to reach the same cooking degree a little more water is needed.
- The Measuring Cup (5) marks are only a guide. Adjust the guantity of water according to your own personal preference.

Cleaning and Maintenance

- Before cleaning, unplug the cooker from the power socket.
- Use a clean damp cloth to wipe the Heating Plate (8). Never immerse the cooker in water to clean.
- Wash the Lid (2) and Cooking Rack (1) and Steaming Platform (9) in hot soapy water.
- Do not scratch the Heating Plate (8) with sharp objects.
- Place the Cooking Rack ① Steaming Platform (9) and Measuring Cup (5) inside the cooker for storage.
